



Camp Outlook's COVID-19 Procedures

Approved by Board of Directors: April 29th, 2021

The following measures are being taken to decrease the risk of COVID-19 in our programming. These measures are subject to change based on public health guidance. All participants will be informed of the most current procedures on the day of their programming.

- Volunteers will receive **specific training** on the spread of COVID-19. This will include training on the importance and enforcement of Outlook's protocols for mitigating such spread.
- The following **health screening** will be administered to all participants and volunteers over the phone prior to and in person at the start of each program:
 - If the answer is yes to any of the following questions, we cannot allow that individual to attend the program:
 - 1) Have you travelled outside of Ontario in the last 14 days?
 - 2) Do you have any of the following new or worsening symptoms or signs? *Symptoms should not be chronic or related to other known causes or conditions.*
 - Fever or chills
 - Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
 - Cough
 - Sore throat, trouble swallowing
 - Runny nose/stuffy nose or nasal congestion
 - Decrease or loss of smell or taste
 - Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain
 - Not feeling well, extreme tiredness, sore muscles
 - 3) Have you been in close contact with a person showing symptoms or tested positive for COVID-19?
- **Physical distancing** (i.e. staying 2m apart whenever possible) will be required throughout the duration of programming.
- **Mask-wearing** will be required for volunteers and for campers throughout the duration of programming, except for any individuals with a medical condition that makes it difficult to wear a mask. We will provide masks to anyone who does not arrive with one.
- We will provide our group **transportation**, reducing risk of transmission by:
 - Opening bus windows to improve ventilation.
 - Spacing out seating arrangements and grouping by trip 'cohort'.
 - Sanitizing the bus between each use.
- Mandatory, supervised use of **antiviral hand sanitizer** by all members of the program regularly, including after using the washroom, before handling and/or eating food.
